Getting Started

1. The groaning earth: How widespread is the pain? Why do some people think Christians are protected from it? What is this? – Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, and live life together. We call them 1:10 Community Groups (the "1:10" comes from Colossians 1:10). The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a

Digging Deeper

- 3. Read the following passages and note the one phrase that is reoccurring in these verses: Romans 8:19, 23, 25; Galatians 5:5; 1 Corinthians 1:7; Philippians 3:20; & Hebrews 9:28. What were they eagerly awaiting in each of these verses?
- 4. Think about the fall of mankind: How does that relate? In what way do we keep on falling sometimes? How far can we correct our course?
- 5. In Paul's description of "creation being subjected to **futility**" (Rom. 8:20), he uses the same word that Solomon uses in Ecclesiastes—"vanity."
- 6. Read Ecclesiastes 12:1-8 in the NLT version. How does Solomon depict the process of growing older in these verses? How many of these can you relate to at this point in life?
- 7. What does Solomon (and Paul) conclude about the matter (Eccl. 12:8).
- 8. How is the behavior of such a person visibly proven? Do you know someone who would be classified as a "person of integrity" or a "blameless" person?
- 9. Read Romans 8:24-25. What is our sure hope? How should it affect out daily outlook? How should that show?
- 10. Talk with one another about what Paul is trying to say in these two verses regarding hope and perseverance

- 11. **Read Titus 2:13-14.** What are we to be looking forward to in this passage? How are we to live <u>now</u> while we wait?
- 12. Share together what good work you want to "be zealous" for in 2019.
