What is this? – Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, and live life together. We call them 1:10 Community Groups (the “1:10” comes from Colossians 1:10). The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a parallel passage of Scripture), and guide each group’s study. If you’re interested in connecting with a 1:10 Group, let us know on the Connect Card in your bulletin.

Getting Started

1. Perhaps you have heard the phrase, “If you’re going to talk the talk, you’ve got to walk the walk”—what does this mean? Give an example of where you have seen this phrase either lived out or not lived out.
2. **Review the passages of Ephesians (2:1-2, 10; 4:1,17; 5:1-2,8,15).** Review your message notes. What stood out to you from the message this week? Do you have questions? Disagreements? Discuss it with your group.

Digging Deeper

3. According to **Eph. 2:1-3**, the zombie apocalypse is true! What type of life was Paul describing in these three verses? Talk about ways you have seen “zombies--i.e. “the spiritually dead”--living out these 3 verses in today's world/society.
4. How is a person either led by the spirit of the world or led by the Holy Spirit according to verses 2 & 3? Should we be surprised at New York’s recent abortion law based on these verses?
5. **Read Eph. 2:10.** What is Paul talking about with regards to “good works?” Compare Phil. 2:12-13 with this verse and talk through the fuller explanation of why we are to perform “good works.
6. **Read Eph. 4:1.** What does it mean to “walk worthy of your calling?” (Hint: Keep reading!) Describe ways you have seen this type of walk lived out.
7. **Read Eph. 5:1-2.** What does Paul mean when he says, “walk in love?” How is this lived out practically in your job, home, church, sporting events, etc.?
8. **Read Eph. 5:** Discuss what Paul means when he says, “walk as children of light.”
9. **Read Eph. 5:15.** What are the two ways of walking that Paul gives in this passage? How is this accomplished?

Up Close

10. How can you spot the difference between someone who is only displaying an outward obedience or one who conveys an inward transformation?
11. Are you talking the talk or truly walking the walk?
