HOMework

What is this? – Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, and live life together. We call them 1:10 Community Groups (the “1:10” comes from Colossians 1:10). The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a parallel passage of Scripture), and guide each group’s study. If you’re interested in connecting with a 1:10 Group, let us know on the Connect Card in your bulletin.

Getting Started

1. **Getting to Know You:** *In general, would you rather be in control of a situation? Or let someone else take control and lead?*
2. *Describe a time in your life where you felt the most out of control and/or had to exercise the most faith to trust God through a situation...*
3. **Read Exodus 11:1-10.** Review your message notes. What stood out to you from the message this week? Do you have questions? Disagreements? Discuss it with your group.

Digging Deeper

4. One pastor has said that faith is “trusting God enough to do what he says.” **Hebrews 11** is full of people who did just that. Read through the whole chapter and jot down where you see the various people trusting God enough to do what he says and the results of them doing that.
5. What stands out to you about faith from this chapter?
6. In light of what you saw in the lives of the people mentioned in this chapter, what are some of the things we should expect when we are in the middle of God’s will?
7. Check out this list of 6 things that can sabotage your faith and simple obedience to God.
 1. Letting your *conscience* be your guide. **1 Corinthians 4:4; Proverbs 12:15 & 14:12**
 2. Asking for more *proof* when God has already spoken *clearly*. **Judges 6:36-40; 8:22-27**
 3. Confusing *risk* with *faith*. **Luke 14:28-32; Proverbs 19:3**
 4. Failing to check in with God because the decision seems *obvious*. **Joshua 9:1-27; Jn 8:44**
 5. Asking God *what to do* without asking him *when to do it*. **Acts 7:20-36; John 7:3-6**
 6. If you’re married, ignoring your *spouse*. **Genesis 2:24; Ephesians 5:21-25; 1 Peter 3:7**
8. Review the list above. Look up some of the Scripture. Of the six things mentioned that can sabotage your faith, which one do you struggle with the most?
9. What could help you to minimize its impact on your faith?
10. One of the incredible things about God’s will is that no matter how far we’ve gone off track, God is ready and willing to bring us back. How do the following verses help reinforce God’s desire to restore us, work in us, and use us for his will no matter how far we’ve fallen off track?
