God's way is often THE LONG WAY, (v. 17-18, 20)

It's usually not hard to find...

...but it's harder and longer than we would choose

Getting Started

1. **Getting to Know You:** This week we heard the "long way" is sometimes definitely the better way to go, even though it may not make sense. Do you have any illustrations in your own life of this happening?

What is this? – Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, and live life together. We call them 1:10 Community Groups (the "1:10" comes from Colossians 1:10). The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a parallel passage of Scripture), and guide each group's study. 2. **Read Exodus 13:17-22.** Review your message notes. What stood out to you from the message this week? Do you have questions? Disagreements? Discuss it with your group.

Digging Deeper

3. Our access to Scripture within our culture is amazing when you consider that we can access it almost instantly anywhere due to the Internet. Yet "access" doesn't always equal "accuracy" as verses can easily be taken out of context. One of the best ways to guarantee that we are properly interpreting any verse or passage is to compare it with the rest of the Bible. Read the verses below and answer the question in each column.
