Ask **and it will be given to you**

Getting Started

1. As a child, what did you want to grow up to be and why?

What is this? – Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, and live life together.We call them 1:10 Community Groups (the "1:10" comes from Colossians 1:10). The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a parallel passage of Scripture), and guide each group's study. If you're interested in connecting with a 1:10 Group, let us know on the Connect Card in your bulletin.

2. **Read Matthew 7:7-11.** Review your message notes. What stood out to you from the message this week? Do you have questions? Disagreements? Discuss it with your group.

Digging Deeper

- 3. How do you respond when a child asks you for something? In what circumstances would you say "Yes" and what circumstances would you say "No"? How does God respond when we ask for something?
- 4. Do you struggle to believe that God always responds to his children? If so, why?
- 5. In verses **Matthew 7:7-8**, the disciples are told to ask, seek, and knock. What do these three words have in common? As Pastor Rick showed us, they are also very different from one another. What are some of the ways that they are different?
- 6. Read **Matthew 6:8-13**. How does that passage of scripture compliment the passage of **Matthew 7:7-11**?
- 7. Listening is one of the hardest elements of prayer because we are not filling up the silence with our own thoughts, words, and intentions. A response to the instructions of prayer that Matthew 7:7-11 sets up for us, is to listen. What are some disciplines that we can practice to help us become more comfortable with listening?
- 8. Read Matthew 7:12. How would the world be better if we practiced this teaching?

- 9. What is the BIG story here that Jesus hopes we will take away from this teaching? How can you apply it to your daily prayer life?
- 10. Prayer requests? Using the guidelines that Jesus set forth for us, end in prayer.
