#### **Getting Started**

- 1. **Getting to Know You:** Would you rather...
  - Go way back in time and meet your ancestors (pre-1800's) or go way into the future and meet your great-grandchildren (post 2200)?
  - Have no Internet or no mobile phone?
  - Have a five-star restaurant personal chef who can prepare any meal at any time of day or a chauffeur that can drive you to and from anywhere you want in any vehicle of your choice?
- 2. Review your message notes. What stood out to you from the message this week? What'd you learn? Do you have questions? Disagreements? Discuss it with your group.

#### **Digging Deeper**

- 3. There are a few "greats" that show up in Jesus' teaching. The Great Commandment, the Great Commission and the Great Priority. Take time to look up these verses and discuss them...
  - Matthew 22:36-40 Great Commandment: Love God, Love Others
  - Matthew 28:19-20 Great Commission: Make Disciples
  - Acts 1:8 Great Priority: Ministry should start "here" before it goes "there"
- 4. A lot of times it can be challenging to consistently obey all three of Jesus's "greats". What does Romans 12:10-20 teach us about improving our effectiveness in carrying out these commands?
- 5. Of the three "greats", is there one you need to focus on and/or grow in?
- 6. How could you put that into action?
- 7. In the message this week, we heard that as we seek to be "salt" we can expect to face opposition. The Apostle Paul even faced prison! While in prison he had all his freedoms taken from him. Despite this, Paul was intentional in praying for opportunities to share the Good News with others. **Read Colossians 4:2-6** and summarize Paul's instructions in praying for others.
- 8. How does Paul's example encourage you as you face opposition to the Gospel?
- 9. As God's people, we're to be salt that counters evil and light that advances good as we represent Jesus in this world. One key to representing Jesus well is to recognize that no one is ever argued or forced into the Kingdom. How do these verses help us be sensitive when sharing the Gospel with others and being salt and light in our community?
