The "One Anothers" are the "how-tos" of Christian Friendship...

love covers all the other "one anothers" Matthew 22:39-40; 1 Peter 4:8; 1 Cor. 13

You can be a **FRIEND** who **LOVES** at all times (v. 22)

Proverbs 17:17

even in suffering and hardship 1 Peter 1:1-2

- 1. With a <u>SINCERE</u> love.
 2. With <u>BROTHERLY</u> love.
 3. With an <u>EARNEST</u> love.
 - 4. With a **PURE** love.

4 Ways to Love One Another:

because you are loved **FOR ALL TIME**. (v. 23-25)
