4. In what ways might you "Seek the King" this Christmas season?
5. **Read Psalms 145:1-3 and Psalm 47:1-2.** What is the mood and spirit of these verses?
6. How are you going to "worship the King" this Christmas season?

7. **Read John 19:14-19.** The manger began the long road to the cross. Spend time reflecting on how the King of the Jews died for you. Why did he die? What do you want to do in response?
