## Part 3 | When Life Gets Hard

1 Peter 1:6-9

<sup>6</sup> In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, <sup>7</sup> so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. <sup>8</sup> Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, <sup>9</sup> obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

# Food for Thought...

**Questions & Scripture for Further Study** 

1. James 1:1-12 is a parallel passage to 1 Peter 3:6-9. Take some time to **carefully and thoughtfully read James 1:1-12**, then work through the questions below.

Look carefully at verse 2. How do you do this? Why would James say this

When was a time that you experienced great joy?

What is the difference between joy and happiness?

Read the text carefully: Does James count the trial itself joy? Or something else joy?

How can we possibly be joyful at a time when we are facing trials? (**Of note:** Both Peter and James were writing to Christians who were facing trials and suffering—some of which was intense. — See Acts 8:1-3 and 11:19-20 as examples.)

For more read Romans 5:2-5; Acts 5:41-42; Matthew 5:10-12; 1 Peter 4:12-16; Philippians 3:10-11

- 2. God wants to use trials to grow us in conduct and character. **Read Hebrews 5:14.** Are you the same Christian you were 20 years ago? Will you be the same in another 20? Why or why not? What has caused/will cause this change? What role have trials in your life played?
- 3. **Read James 1:2-4.** What is our role in this process? What is God's?
