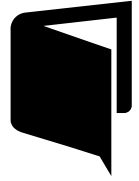

Part 4 | **This Salvation!**

1 Peter 1:10-12

¹⁰ Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, ¹¹ inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories. ¹² It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

1. **Read through 1 Peter 1:10-12** on page 1 of these notes. Circle, underline, or highlight any key words or phrases or words you need to define. Share some of your observations as a group.
2. What aspects of SALVATION are you most grateful for today? His forgiveness, a new life, a home in heaven, a real purpose in life, healing, etc?
3. We may know SALVATION is priceless but it may seem very abstract compared to relationships, \$, things, or awards. How do we keep our focus that our SALVATION IN CHRIST is our greatest treasure today and forever?
4. If someone asked who/what is the Holy Spirit what would you say? What does the Holy Spirit work to reveal to you in **1 Peter 1:11-12**?
5. When you become a Christian it's all about you, and your forgiveness and new life. But eventually the Lord wants you to see it's bigger than you, and that you are called to pass on the faith and serve others. How have you seen God working this process out in your life?
6. **Read Acts 20:24.** How would you describe Paul's attitude about his life and ministry? What motivates or inspires you about his attitude?
7. As part of God's rescue team, who do you want to serve or invite for Christ?
