Part 6 | Two Marks of Real Faith

1 Peter 1:22-2:3

²² Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart, ²³ since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God; ²⁴ for "All flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls, ²⁵ but the word of the Lord remains forever." And this word is the good news that was preached to you. ^{2:1} So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander. ² Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation— ³ if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good.

Digging Deeper

 Peter tells us to "grow up into salvation". Paul says something similar to the church in Ephesus, that they should "grow up in every way into Christ". In his letter to the church of the Thessalonians, Paul describes what it looks like to grow up spiritually in midst of "severe suffering." Read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10. Then jot down how Paul describes the faith of the Thessalonians, himself, and his friends.

What is most attractive to you about how they live out their faith?

How do you think they were able to mature in such a trying situation?

2. Growing up spiritually involves both God's Spirit working in our lives from the inside out, and us working on how God calls us to live (see Philippians 2:12-13). The process of maturing can be hard work. Paul often used the analogy of athletic competition to help Christians understand their part in growing up spiritually. How do the following verses increase or affirm your understanding of what it takes to develop a spiritually mature perspective?

Philippians 3:13-14 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 2 Timothy 2:4-5 Hebrews 12:1-2

3. Growing up spiritually involves both knowledge of God's Word and action on our part. We must live it out, and live holy lives. 1 Thessalonians 5:12-18 gives a list of great things to know and live out as we follow Jesus and impact those around us. As you read the list, which one or two have you seen or do you think would push you toward the most growth?
