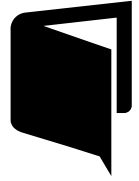

Part 14 | **How to Live Ready**

1 Peter 4:7-11

⁷The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers. ⁸Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. ⁹Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. ¹⁰As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace:

¹¹ whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Digging Deeper

1. We're not sure of all the details or exactly when Jesus will return, but we know that he will. Read the following passages and identify the events yet to happen in each one.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

2 Corinthians 5:10

2. We heard this weekend that one of the key things to living "ready" is to love each other deeply (1 Peter 4:8). What do the following verses tell us about this kind of love in action?

How could you integrate any of these statements about love as you pray for people?

3. Pastor Josh laid out that we want every person to Gather, Grow, and Go. How are you doing with these three? Review the Challenge on the next page and talk about it with your group.

APRIL/MAY/JUNE CHALLENGE:

Gather, Grow, Go!

We want to see every person who calls Wawasee home do 3 things:

1. **Gather** regularly on Sunday mornings. (Hebrews 10:25).
2. **Grow** by getting connect in a growth ministry like a Life Group, Forge, Women's Bible Study, etc. Don't just show up, *grow up!* (1 Corinthians 3:1-3; Heb. 5:12)
3. **Go** serve somewhere! Wawasee Bible will *never* feel like family to you until you're linking arms and serving somewhere. **Where are you serving?** More than ever, we need people willing to serve. (1 Peter 4:10-11)

How are you doing at these three things? Do you need to **Gather** and show up more regularly? Do you need to **Grow** up and get connected in a Life Group? Do you need to **Go** and get off the sidelines and into the game so that you can contribute rather than just consume?
