

# Study Guide **Questions & Scripture for Further Study**

What is this? — Each week people from Wawasee Bible meet in small groups in various homes to learn about Jesus, pray, eat, laugh, & ive life together. We call them Life Groups. The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a related part of Scripture), and guide each group's study. #### **Getting to Know You**

Part of our goal at Life Group is just learning more about each other. Toward that end, here's a <u>random</u> question to discuss and break the ice as you get going. Have everyone answer:

What's the most useless talent you have that you're secretly proud of?

### **Digging Deeper - A Bible Study**

Use this guide for further personal and group study this week. For the most impact in your life and in your group, work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group. If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- 1. It's easy to acknowledge God's omnipotence, but harder to live in faith recognizing it. In Genesis 17-18, Sarai and Abram doubted when God promised a son, yet God asked, "Is anything too difficult for Yahweh?" (Gen **18:14**). Despite their disbelief, God made Sarai a mother, showing his power to accomplish the impossible. **Read Genesis 17:1-18:15.**
- Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Discuss it with your group before moving on.
- In the message this week, Pastor Josh pointed out that God repeated His promise to Abram several times throughout his life, and each time, God made the promise more specific.

Focusing on this dynamic in God's promises regarding land, read Gen 12:1-**3, 7; 13:14–17; 15:1–6, 18–21.** Then, discuss the following questions.

- How do God's promises to give Abram a land get more specific?
- Why do you think God continued to give more specific details?
- How do you think this greater specificity affected Abram's faith in these promises?
- 4. Now let's focus on God's promise of a descendant, read Gen 12:1-3, 7; **13:14–17; 15:1–6, 18–21.** Then, discuss the following questions:
  - How do God's promises to make Abram a great nation get more specific?
  - How do you think the revelation that God's promise would come specifically through the offspring of Abram and Sarai affected Abram's faith in these promises?

## Study Guide (continued)

- 5. Genesis 17 begins with "Abram was ninety-nine years old" when Yahweh appeared again (Gen 17:1). Thirteen years had passed since Gen 15-16. and 24 years since God's call (Gen 12:4). After this wait, Abraham learned Sarah would bear a son within the year (Gen 17:21). Assured, he circumcised every male in his household as commanded (Gen 17:23).
  - Why do you think God waited so long to give Abram and Sarai a son?
  - How would this long wait have affected Abram and Sarai's faith?
  - Reflect on a time when you felt God leading you toward something that you felt was impossible. How did you respond?

#### **Taking It Home**

- 6. The story of Abraham and Sarah is not just about God's promise and faithfulness; it's about discovering God's character as they follow him.
  - When God called Abraham from Ur, he followed without guestion (Gen 12:1). However, decades later, when God said Sarah would have a son, both laughed in doubt (Gen 17:17; 18:12). Their laughter showed they didn't grasp the fullness of God's power and that nothing is too difficult for God (Gen 18:14).

Discuss the following as you wrap up:

- When have you responded in laughter to God's promise in your own life
- How has God convinced you of His omnipotence?
- How does thinking about the Bible as a description of God's character change vour view of God's Word?
- How does thinking of the Bible as a story that tells us who God is affect the way you view your life story?

#### **Prayer**

As you close, take time to pray for each other. **Divide into separate groups of men and women.** Feel free to share requests, just be sure each person gets prayed for.
