BELIEVING, not doubting, that God is **GOOD** (3:1-6)

being **PERSONAL**, not **GENERIC**, with God (3:1-6)

being **OPEN**, not **HIDING** (3:7-10)

CONFESSING, not **BLAMING** (3:11-13)

and living with consequences wrapped in grace. (3:14-24)

5. When life gets difficult or we don't get what we want (or think we deserve), we can struggle with wondering if God can be trusted to look out for us. And, eventually, we lose hope. And if Satan is so bent on convincing us that we can't trust God's care for us, then it would be wise to strengthen our confidence in his care and concern. What truths do you see in these two well known passages that can help you remember that God can be trusted even when we don't understand what he's doing.


