### **Digging Deeper – A Bible Study**

**Use this guide for further personal and group study this week.** For the most impact in your life and in your group, *work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group.* If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- Read Genesis 30:25 to 31:55. (Consider reading it from a translation like the NIrV or a paraphrase like the Message to get a different feel of the narrative.)
   Then take some time to review your message notes. Looking back, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you this week? Discuss it with your group before moving on.
- 2. Do you see any difference or nuance in how God overcame both Jacob's and Laban's dueling schemes?
  - When have you planned or maneuvered to get ahead—like Jacob with his breeding tactics or Laban shuffling his flock (Gen 30:37-39, 30:35). (By the way, it might not necessarily be you scheming, it could just be you being faithful in planning.) What happened, and how did it all play out?
- 3. Read Proverbs 19:21.
  - How does it reshape your view of planning after seeing God override Laban's and Jacob's efforts?
  - How does this challenge or comfort you when your plans hit a wall?
- 4. Thinking back to Pastor Josh's closing story, what's one 'sandcastle'—a plan or dream—you're gripping tightly right now?
  - What makes it hard for you to hold something loosely, whether it's that plan/ dream you just mentioned or something else? Why? Discuss how letting go might look...
